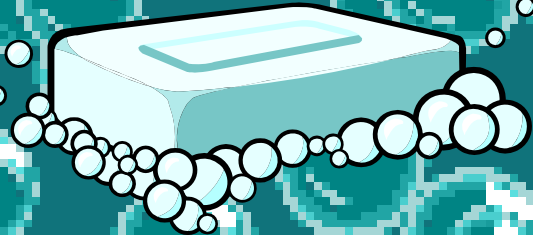
2004 Top Recipient
